NAME OF THE TEXT BOOK: THEMES IN THE WORLD HISTORY

LEARING OBJECTIVES:

- History gives us the tools to analyses and explain problems in the past, it helps us to see the patterns that might otherwise be not known in the present. It provides a crucial perspective for understanding and solving the current and future problems.
- The subject emphasizes that history is a critical discipline, a process of enquiry, a way of knowing about the past, rather than just a collection of facts.
- The syllabus would help the students to understand the process through which historians write history, by choosing and assembling different types of evidence, and by reading their sources critically. They will appreciate how historians follow the trails that lead to the past, and how historical knowledge develops.

LEARNING OUTCOMES: THE STUDENTS WILL BE ABLE TO

- Focus on some important developments in different spheres-political, social, cultural and economic.
- Study not only the grand narratives of development-urbanization, industrialization and modernization-but also to know about the processes of displacements and marginalization. Through the study of these themes' students will acquire a sense of the wider historical processes as well as an idea of the specific debates around them.
